Johnson Piano Academy Code of Conduct

• **Clothing Is Required At All Times.** Participants who are not dressed will be permanently removed from the studio with no refunds, no exceptions.

- Offensive language is not allowed. This includes hate speech and explicit language.
- Be Kind and Respectful. Students should be supportive of one another. Repeat offenders will be removed from class and, if necessary, the studio.
- Turn off your microphone unless asked to speak or play for the group.
- Don't want to be called on? Turn off your camera until you are ready to actively participate.
- All Students need the following at the piano:
 - A pencil
 - Paper or a white board
 - Practice worksheets for taking practice notes
 - Their Music
- Even better:
 - A white board (or a DIY music white board)
 - Post-its and/ or Highlighter tape

- Whenever possible, the camera should be placed to show student hands and posture.
- Students level 2 and up need to number their measures
- If possible, the lesson area should be quiet without a lot of extra activity.
- Headphones are not required, but they can help students focus on the lesson.
